Scope of Work #1 Roof

Building Description

Opening in 1888, the two-story limestone building with a prominent terne-metal roof served as a depot for the Southern Kansas and then AT&SF railroad lines until 1962, the when the structure was donated to the Franklin County Historical Society, which reopened the building as the Old Depot Museum in 1963.

Project Description

Repairing both the terne-metal roof and wooden platform roof to prevent future water damage.

Detail of Work

- Remove existing roofing materials, assess roof sheathing and underlying structure, repair and/or replace any damaged sheathing, install new roofing, flashing, and/or drip edge per guidance in Preservation Brief #10 and per plans to be approved by SHPO
- Repair, stabilize, and/or replace deteriorated woodwork per plans to be approved by SHPO
- Clean and recoat metal roof with GACO or equivalent coating per guidance in Preservation Brief #6 and per plans to be approved by SHPO.

General Conditions

- Repair work to be in accordance with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation. Viewable at https://www.nps.gov/tps/standards//rehabilitation/rehab/stand.htm
- Certificates of insurance, performance, and materials payment bonds required as security for faithful performance and the payment of all bills and obligation arising from the contract.
- Storage and handling of all materials must be in a manner which prevents additional loss, deterioration and damage; storage area to be designated by project administrator.
- All work subject to review by the Kansas State historical Society throughout the duration of the project.
- Compliance with all applicable laws and statutory regulations required.
